- LGF Monitoring regime relatively 'light touch' all project quarterly monitoring data is entered into a national database.





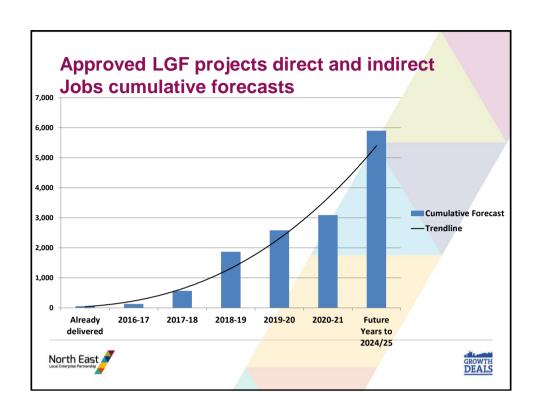
