Executive Summary

The purpose of this report is to provide an interim report to the Leadership Board on the progress of Transport for the North (TfN) in its proposal to become a Sub-National Transport Body (STB) pending the submission of a full and detailed report in advance of the forthcoming meeting.

Recommendations

The Leadership Board is recommended to note the contents of this report.



1. Background Information

- 1.1 At its meeting on 18th July 2017 the Leadership Board considered a report concerning Transport for the North's (TfN) proposal to become a Sub-National Transport Body (STB). The report outlined the process by which TfN is intended to become a STB and the part that NECA may play in it.
- 1.2 The report also sought the consent of the Leadership Board to the making of Regulations by the Secretary of State to allow TfN to become a STB.
- 1.3 The Leadership Board decided at its meeting on 18th July 2017 to defer the report in order to enable additional information to be provided in relation to certain key matters. The full report to the meeting of the Leadership Board on 7 August will be available next week and will provide the requisite information sought.

2. Proposals

- 2.1 The Leadership Board will be invited on 7th August 2017 to consent to the making of Regulations under section 102E of the Local Transport Act 2007 by the Secretary of State to establish TfN as a Sub-National Transport Body.
- 2.2 TfN are carrying out further work to develop the required Regulations, but the final version of the Draft Regulations is not expected to be available before the meeting of the Leadership Board. As a result, the Leadership Board will be invited to delegate authority to the Head of Paid Service in consultation with others to consent to the participation of NECA in the Sub-National Transport Body, Transport for the North. Such consent if given will enable the relevant regulations to be laid before Parliament by the Secretary of State in a timely way and enable the creation of the new statutory body, to be created in the Spring of 2018.
