## 5. Executive Summary

This delegated decision will approve and allocate £9,697,698 funding from the Bus Service Improvement Plan to the Intelligent Transport Systems (ITS) programme, following successful appraisal in accordance with the Transport Assurance Framework. This falls below the allocation identified in the BSIP and approved by JTC (£13,040,000) following appraisal.

Delegated authority was sought from the Joint Transport Committee for the Transport North East Managing Director, in consultation with the Monitoring Officer and the Section 73 Officer, subject to successful appraisal of the schemes in line with the Transport Assurance Framework, to approve the scheme and enter into Grant Funding Agreements and make payments.

This decision will enact parts two and three of this item. Part one will be determined separately.
